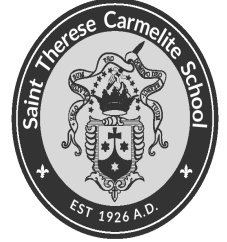

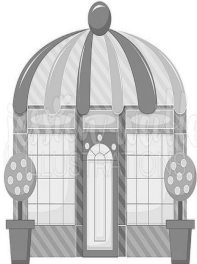

ALL PROCEEDS will benefit our Religious Education programs!



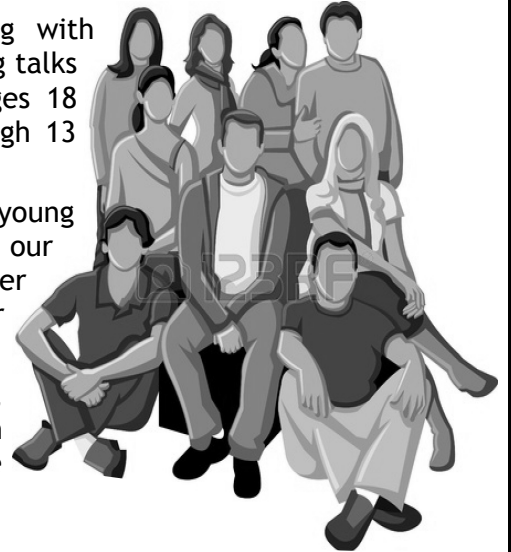
