## Safety and Courtesy during Morning Drop Off

Please review these procedures for the safety of all our children and to keep traffic flowing smooth during drop-off and dismissal:

1. **Stay in the car line during morning drop off and dismissal.** It is dangerous for children to walk through the line of moving cars when they are dropped off or picked up in the parking lot.
2. **Have children ready to exit the car.** Be courteous: be sure children have their backpacks on ready to exit the car as soon as it stops at the front of the building. This will keep the carline moving and shorten drop off times in the morning.
3. **Observe the 10 mph speed limit and do not pull around other cars.** Speeding and pulling around other cars during morning drop off causes accidents.
