****Reminder: Only solid-colored t-shirts will be allowed this year. Bras must be worn.**

 2½"	LENGTH: Shorts, skirts, dresses, or jumpers must be no shorter than 2½ inches above the knee (width of a dollar bill). This applies to both male and female students.
 	PANTS: Jeans, shorts or pants must be “free of rips and tears” above the knee.
 	PAJAMAS: Pajama tops and bottoms, house, indoor slippers, lounge shoes or blankets are not permitted unless approved by campus administration on specified days.
 	SHIRTS: Shirts, t-shirts, blouses, and polo shirts with either a short or long sleeve that are free of pictures, emblems, or writing that is lewd, offensive, vulgar, obscene, gang-related or depict drugs, alcohol, vaping or tobacco products.
 	COVERAGE: Garment's material must be solid (non-transparent) and cover the midriff, lower back and chest and all clothing may not reveal undergarments in any way. Halter, tube and spaghetti-strap tops (less than 1" in width) are not permitted.
	JACKETS: Students who choose to wear a zippered jacket to cover clothing that does not meet dress code expectations must ensure that the jacket is worn upon entry to the building and remains fully zippered throughout the school day. Jackets may not be removed or unzipped if the clothing underneath is out of compliance with the dress code.
	FOOTWEAR: Appropriate footwear must be worn. Steel toed boots can only be worn, during instructional time, when it is part of a course such as Career and Technical Education. House, indoor slippers and lounge shoes are not permitted.
	SAFETY: Any clothing that may pose a safety concern, as determined by campus administration, is prohibited.
 FINAL DETERMINATION: Final determination of acceptable dress and grooming rests with the principal or designee.	

Enforcement

If the Principal or designee determines that the student's grooming or clothing violates the school's dress code, the student will be given the opportunity to correct the violation at school and return to the classroom.

If it cannot be corrected at school, the parent or appropriate family designee must drop off at school appropriate clothing for the student to change into.

If the student refuses to comply, they will be subjected to disciplinary action.
