#### St. Anne School and CYO Volunteers. . .

Thank you to so many of you who have recently applied for and completed your Child Protection Clearances. I work on a part-time basis both remotely and in the rectory – please don't hesitate to contact me. This is an extremely busy time for so many obtaining and updating volunteer clearances for CYO, School and Parish events/activities. Communication by email works best.

I know this is a tedious task, but a necessary one, and required by law to keep our children safe. St. Anne School/Parish is grateful for your cooperation.

Many of you have asked me about the volunteer badges...they are slowing arriving ...this is a new process. There are several steps involved in finalizing your final approval status on the Diocesan-wide system, which results in the badges being created. I am working to speed up that process. They will arrive.

#### A couple of tips:

- Keep your original clearances and send me copies only. You may need clearances for other activities outside of St. Anne involving your children. Keep a file at home.
- 2. Read the directions CAREFULLY and pay attention to the forms sent to you...the State and the Diocese issue updates from time to time. PLEASE READ THE PARENT COMMUNICATION EVERY WEEK.
- 3. Once you receive your badge, please wear it for <u>ALL SCHOOL/CYO ACTVITIES</u> <u>AND EVENTS</u>. You can volunteer until your badge arrives!
- CYO-a reminder....the three CYO DIOCESAN clearances are required for EVERY COACH at the <u>beginning of every academic year</u> – regardless of the season in which you volunteer or coach.


Rehearsals will take place during school hours. Students will enjoy participating in all the pre-show preparations and rehearsals even if they cannot be present for the final performance.


