L (Local) Salary Schedule Revised September 1, 2023

- A: \$7.79 per hour (*Minimum Wage*)
Workstudy
- B: \$7.79 per hour (*Minimum Wage*) up to any hourly rate not to exceed limitations described below
Regardless of the appropriate step placement, in no event should a part-time employee be paid a higher wage or salary under a local salary schedule than he/she would be entitled to if paid a pro-rata salary based on the C, D, or E salary schedule. Part-time Adult Education Teachers hired on or after July 1, 2008 placed on a local schedule or on Schedule D3, Rank I, Step 0 cannot exceed a maximum rate of \$13.62 per hour. (The maximum hourly rate in the preceding statement only refers to Step 0 and should be adjusted accordingly.)

Regardless of the appropriate step placement, in no event should a part-time employee be paid a higher wage or salary under a local salary schedule than he/she would be entitled to if paid a pro-rata salary based on the C, D, or E salary schedule. Part-time Adult Education Teachers hired on or after July 1, 2008 placed on a local schedule or on Schedule D3, Rank II, Step 0 cannot exceed a maximum rate of \$18.73 per hour. (The maximum hourly rate in the preceding statement only refers to Step 0 and should be adjusted accordingly.)
