Tech Tasks to End the School Year

Clean out your documents – Sort through the documents you collected this year and get rid of those you don't need anymore. Or create an "Old" folder and move those documents to it or save them to a flash drive or your Google Drive.

Empty the trash – Right click on the Recycle Bin icon, typically located in the upper left corner of your computer screen, and click "Empty Recycle Bin."

Clean out your subscriptions – Get rid of subscriptions that you no longer use or apply to your needs that come to your email daily. All you have to do is scroll to the bottom of the email for the subscription you want to get rid of and click "Unsubscribe."
