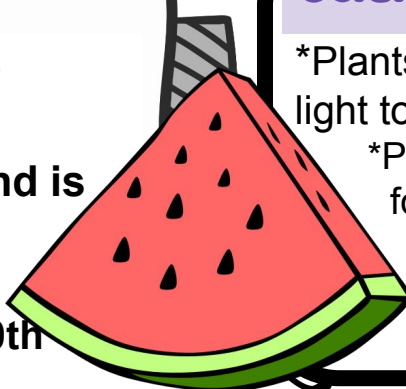
Class News
