Pleasant Home School Vehicle Permit Warning! Vehicles Subject to Search

Any vehicle entering the school area is subject to search by school authorities and law enforcement personnel working with them. Search of vehicle includes all compartments thereof. Once search begins the person in control of the vehicle will not be permitted to remove vehicle from the premises during the reasonable duration of the search.

Driving your vehicle to school is a privilege, not a right. To keep this privilege you will need to follow a few basic rules.

- 1. Once vehicle is parked, the student will immediately leave the parking lot and not return without a pass or until school is over. The only people that can issue a pass are the Principal or his designee.
- 2. All drivers (must be in at least 9th grade) on campus will obey safety precautions and all Alabama state driving laws:
 - A. No speeding 15 MPH only
 - B. No reckless driving as determined by the Principal or his designee
 - C. Vehicles must comply with state law and all vehicles driven on campus must have insurance
 - D. Follow all traffic control signs (One Way, Stop, etc.)
 - E. No loud music
- 3. All vehicles must have current school parking permit displayed in plain view and visible on rearview mirror. If driving another vehicle student must display parking permit in that vehicle.
- 4. The Principal and SRO (School Resource Officer) have the right to change these rules at any time for the safety and well-being of the school.
- The school may issue citations for violations. Penalties include written warning recess detention – Saturday School – I.S.S. days without vehicle on campus – traffic ticket by SRO. One who is issued a referral must contact SRO within 2 days. Vehicles may be towed off campus at owner's expense if situation dictates such action is necessary.
- 6. If parking permit tag is lost or not turned in at end of school a replacement of \$5 will be due by student.
