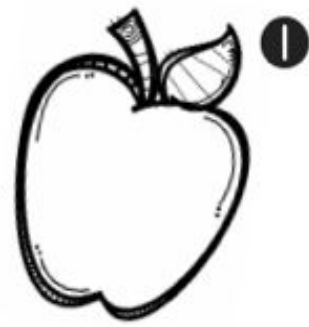

2nd Grade Show

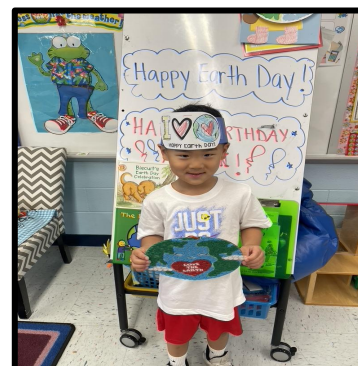
