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- New Priest and Deacon assignments
 - All expectations are that Fr Jason & Fr Felipe will stay at SJCS
 - Additional deacon support expected to come
- Connecting with the rest of the parish
 - Kudos to Fran for parish connection with school.

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- Facility Manager Update
 - o No update on resume review for facility managers
 - AC repairs took precedence
- Updates
 - Our TU3 (pre-school and west side of school) is back up and running. AC finally blowing out cool air

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Budget review (Phil)

- 79.5K reimbursement processed for Catholic foundations
- 15K donation received from grandparent after the grandparent's day celebration
 - o 10K recurring in scholarship & 5K for athletics
- 10 months end of April
 - o nothing out of the ordinary in April
 - Received the Catholic foundation grant in May (covered 5th grade laptops & iPad for 2-4th grade)
 - o insurance rates will be charged double in May due to renegotiations with diocese
- Cash position
 - o 33K unrestricted from auction

- o 4K tuition assistance will roll over to next year
- o 20K donation from parishioner will be added to endowment fund
- o 36K from N. Texas Giving Day
- o 975 in reserved
- o 555 3 months holdover
- o 74.5 next year tuition
- 345 rainy day fund
- o 143 endowment
- o 321 hold to school
- next year's budget
 - o based on 265 enrollment
 - o added back athletics to pre-pandemic rates
 - o added back in full field trips & pines trips
 - o 82% of budget is insurance and compensation/benefits
 - o included a 3.9% increase in staff
 - o 40K to pay the school
 - o 265 enrollment would give a net loss of 41K but cash basis would be up 76K???
 - Confident in the enrollment being up to 270
 - o if we are 270 enrollment then we break even
 - Discussion on approval of budget set at 270 enrollment not 265
 - Fr Jason urged us to be conservative in planning budgets when tied to enrollment
 - We feel the path to 270 students is strong since we are awaiting at least 6 student responses to enrollment
 - o Meredith makes a motion to move budget summary to reflect enrollment at 270
 - Kevin 2nd
 - Passes
 - Phil will re-assess numbers
 - o CD conversation
 - Interest rate is .2% is same for 30days-3month-6month
- facilities discussion
 - Gym AC unit is ordered but on delay for delivery
 - O Kitchen Ac unit needs to be replaced but still operational
- Teacher Bonus
 - Recommended for approval of \$32,000
