Minimum Requirements - Applicants must be certified, endorsed by the State Department of Education, and meet highly qualified requirements with five (5) years teaching experience. follow regulations established by school system and state, and other duties as assigned by the Director of Schools.

Duties include but are not limited to: prepare and conduct professional development for teachers; analyze TCAP Data and prepare reports for teachers and administrators as needed; prepare/update and maintain pacing guides, standards documents and assessments for classroom teacher use; support standards checks process; support Instructional Coaches with RTI process; Assist and monitor teacher access to textbooks, materials and platforms used for Math/grade levels supported; train and support new teachers; plan and support collaborative planning for teachers; working with teachers and students at multiple buildings, monitoring and sharing information from TDOE website; monitoring data spreadsheets with TCAP, universal screener, classroom assessments and benchmark assessment data, etc. Work with district leaders to develop system plan and support implementation of actions steps, high quality instructional materials and high impact instructional strategies in math classrooms.
