



## COVID-19 General Notification Letter in Educational Setting

9/7/21

Dear Staff,

Huron County Health Department has notified us on 9/7/21 of a probable or confirmed COVID-19 case amongst students, teachers, staff members, coaches, volunteers, or any other person who was present on Huron ISD property or at a school function under circumstances that may result in the transmission or contraction of COVID-19 during their infectious period.

- Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed location have been completed.
- If you were identified as a close contact with a confirmed individual, you will or have been contacted by the Huron ISD and/or the Huron County Health Department. Please follow the recommendations that are provided.
- All unvaccinated confirmed cases should be isolated and close contacts quarantined for 14-days from last exposure in order to prevent illness in new persons. “Close contact” means being a household or staff member, intimate contact, or caregiver of a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case; within 6 feet of the confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case for more than 15 minutes, even if wearing a non-medical face covering; or having unprotected contact with the infected person’s body fluids and/or secretions, for example, being coughed or sneezed on. Fully vaccinated close contacts should monitor for symptoms for 14-days and seek a COVID test 3-5 days after date of exposure.
- Please note that all information, including the name(s) of ill persons, is confidential in order to protect patient privacy.
- In accordance with [MDHHS Emergency Order Under MCL 333.2253 – Reporting of Confirmed and Probable Cases of COVID-19 at Schools](#), This notice has been posted within 24 hours to the district website on 9/7/21
