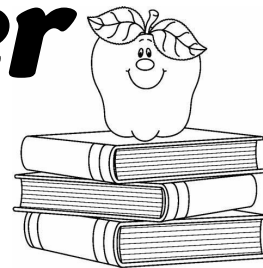

Notes From the Superintendent

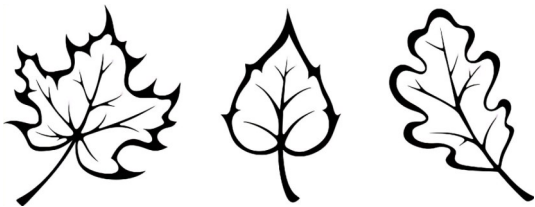
We have completed the first few weeks of school and I am pleased to state that we are off to a great start. I want to thank parents for their efforts in preparing their students for the start of school and for attending the Back to School Night on August 14, 2023. We had excellent attendance and students were able to meet their teachers, deliver supplies, and organize their lockers. Parent and student participation in this annual event helps the first days of school go smoothly so thank you for your participation. One of the strengths of our district is parent engagement and support.

In cooperation with the Carroll County Sheriff's Office our district has instituted a School Resource Officer Program. Officer Dan Nevills will be working with staff and students to enhance safety and security within our building. In addition, he will be building relationships with students, parents, and community to enhance trust between law enforcement and our communities. Officer Nevills will also provide training to staff and students throughout the school year. We are pleased to offer this added layer of security and Officer Nevills will be present each school day and at various after-school events. Please make an effort to welcome Officer Nevills when you visit the building.

We wish to remind parents that the school buildings are not open before 8:00 A.M, at which time school employees will enable students to enter through the various doors. Students or parents arriving after 8:15 A.M. need to enter through the following buzzer release door: Milledgeville School – North rear main entrance from the parking lot (large orange fascia). All exterior doors are locked from the outside on a permanent basis during the school day to enhance safety and security.

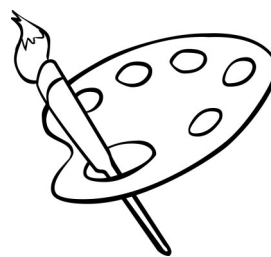

School Reach Automated Telephone Contact System

When the administration decides to close school, dismiss early, or wants to provide an important reminder to parents we will execute a School Reach call. When a School Reach call is made a recorded message will be sent to the contact numbers you provide the school district during registration. Please make sure that the contact numbers we have for your family are accurate and up to date. Warning: In the case of school closing you will receive phone call notification very early in the morning i.e. 5:00 A.M. If this is not acceptable notify in writing the office secretary in the building your child attends that you would like to be removed from the School Reach telephone notification program.
