The topic for these two classes will be the **SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION**. The Catechism says this: “The Sacraments of Initiation—Baptism, the Eucharist, and Confirmation—lay the foundation of every Christian life. These sacraments are deeply interconnected and progressively draw the faithful into the mystery of divine life. The sharing in the divine nature given to men through the grace of Christ bears a certain likeness to the origin, development, and nourishing of natural life (CC 1212). Those who have been raised to the dignity of the royal priesthood by Baptism, and configured more deeply to Christ by Confirmation, participate with the whole community in the Lord's own sacrifice by means of the Eucharist.”
