- Strong vocal music teaching skills required
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills required
- Patience and positivity as a role model for high school students required
- Ability to work professionally and collaboratively with the director as well as the music, design, and costume departments required
- Ability to pass a background check

<u>Position Responsibilities:</u> The Vocal Music Teacher works closely with the Directors to develop, teach, and refine all music that the students will be singing in the show. This role includes assisting with rehearsals, working with students, ensuring consistency, and supporting the overall vision of the production.

The selected candidate will have the responsibilities shown below. Other reasonable duties may be assigned by the immediate supervisor or their designee.

- 1. Provide assistance to the theater director in preparing for and executing the spring musical.
- 2. Attend all scheduled rehearsals January April 22, 2026 and show dates April 23-26, 2026 including those held in the evenings and on weekends.
- 3. Collaborate with the music, design, and costume departments to ensure the music is appropriate and can be executed in the show.
- 4. Provide vocal music training and support to all singers in the cast.
- 5. Attend all performances supporting the singers, other cast members, and support staff.
- 6. Serve as a role model for Morgantown High School students demonstrating appropriate language and actions at all times.

7. Represent Morgantown High School, the MHS Theater Department and EPIC in a positive and professional way at all times.
