Dear St. Anne School/Parish Volunteers,

All Volunteers who are approved and have completed all their required clearances will receive a **volunteer badge**. These badges are color-coded based on the date of when your first PA State clearance will expire. The date is listed on your badge.

Badges are created on a monthly basis by the Diocesan Safe Environment Office. Don't worry if your badge has not yet arrived; it will take a while as the office is responsible for nearly 9,000 volunteers Diocese-wide.

Once you receive your badge, it must be worn at all School Volunteer and CYO events, practices, etc.






