★ SUPPORTING YOUR STUDENT AT HOME

★ OUR LEARNING

Reading- I can use photographs and text features to answer questions. I can find evidence in the story..

Phonics- I can read and write words with r-blends. I can read and write words with digraph -ck and double final consonants. I can read and write words with inflectional ending -s and -ing.

Writing: I can write an informative text. I can work with noun-verb agreement. I can identify the subject and predicate of a sentence.

Math- I can write numbers 1-70. I can add subtract within 10, including with word problems.

Science/Social Studies- I can discuss my role in my community.
