

Please read and make sure you are aware of the following points regarding DE.

Dual Enrollment (DE)/Middle College (MC) Notes

- DE/MC classes are classes that provide both high school and college credits.

- DE/MC Requirements for ALL College Level Classes

- **Ms. Wood needs to be informed of your interest in DE classes.**

- Students need to have self-discipline and good work ethics.

- Students must meet and maintain the enrollment standards set by the selected college.

- Students must be 15 years old.

- RCHS counselors recommend a 21 ACT Composite Score.

- Students must not have a semester grade lower than a B in any course related to the subject matter of the college course.

- TCAP/EOC scores in related courses must be “On Track” or “Mastered”.

- If a student is 18 and male, the student needs to have registered for Selective Service.

- Some colleges require specific ACT scores for some classes. The April ACT will be the last ACT that can be used to qualify for Fall Classes.

- **Spring 2023 Registration due date is November 18, 2022.**

- **Fall 2023 Registration due date is April 4, 2023.**

- **Selecting DE classes**

- Students/Parents need to research the college and the major you are interested in to ensure the class(es) the student picks will be accepted.

- PreCal is not required for every major!

- **Dropping DE**

- It is the student's responsibility to let **both** Rhea County High School and the DE college know if the student wants to drop a DE class.

- **Grades**

- Students will be awarded 4 additional numerical points to the raw score received from the college.

- If a raw score is not provided, RCHS will use the state recommended grading scale for letter grades.

- **Disclaimer**

- These are the guidelines set by RCHS for our students that pursue college level classes while in high school regardless of the name of the program (Dual Enrollment, Early College, Middle College, etc).

- The CNA program is a separate program with its own requirements.

- Completion of SAILS Math to a DE class has different requirements.

- If a student takes DE English in the fall, the student must take DE English in the spring.

- Every DE class awards 1 credit each semester.

- Middle College students need to be Math Science Elective Focus going into their sophomore year in order to get the required math courses.

- Selecting DE classes

- Bryan College may require ACT scores for certain classes.
- Bryan College has an option to include PreCal 1 and PreCal 2 in one class worth 4 college credits (MATH 117).
- If you take DE English (ENG 109) in the fall, you must take DE English (ENG 110) in the spring.

- Registering for DE Classes at Bryan College

- Classes cost approximately \$176 per credit hour **plus course fee. Books and materials are an additional cost.**
- Students who are male and will be 18 prior to the first day of class, you need to register with Selective Services at www.SSS.gov.

- **Selecting DE classes**

- PreCal I (3 hours) requires 22 Math and 19 Reading ACT subscores.
- PreCal 2 (4 hours) requires 24 Math and 19 Reading ACT subscores or PreCal 1.
- Statistics (3 hours) requires 19 Math and 19 Reading ACT subscores.
- Comp I (3 hours) requires 19 Reading and 18 English ACT subscores.
 - If a student takes DE English in the fall, the student MUST take DE English in the spring.

- Registering for DE (Early College) Classes at Chattanooga State

- Classes cost approximately \$181 per credit hour **plus additional fees and books**
- <https://www.chattanoogastate.edu/early-college>.
 - Follow the instructions.
 - The student needs to check their email to obtain their Chattanooga State ID (A#).
 - Students will choose courses for the semester for which they are registering (NOT THE ENTIRE YEAR).
 - If the student is 18 or will turn 18 prior to the first day of class, the student will need to submit a copy of their Driver License at submit@chattanoogastate.edu and earlycollege@chattanoogastate.edu.
 - If the student is male and will be 18 prior to the first day of class, the student will need to register with Selective Services at www.SSS.gov.

Roane State

- **Roane State DE (Middle College) Information and Contacts**

- Students must be a Math Science Elective Focus student.
- Students must qualify for Honors Geometry and Honors Algebra II their sophomore year.
- Students must register for Middle College spring of their sophomore year.

- **Registering for Middle College Classes at Roane State**

- The student will register with Ms. Wood before the April deadline for fall DE classes their sophomore year. Students will also attend an information session with Roane State to complete their course requests.

- Students get the following amounts.
 - 1st class – tuition and fees
 - 2nd class – tuition and fees
 - 3rd class – tuition and fees
 - 4th class – tuition and fees
 - 5th - tuition and fees
 - 6th – 10th class - You can receive \$100 per credit hour (enhanced grant). (Bryan College has a \$200 scholarship starting with the sixth class in addition to the enhanced grant. This results in a typical 3 credit class having zero tuition.)
- Book fees are not included in the fees the DE Grant covers.
- **To continue to be eligible for DE grant, you must earn a cumulative 2.0 college GPA.**

- Middle College Grant

- Students get \$2000 per semester.
- **To continue to be eligible for MC grant, students must earn a semester 3.0 college GPA.**
