Appointments are available on a first come, first served basis and pre-registration is required. The appointments will be free or low cost for families. Nurses are able to treat mild/moderate conditions, high blood pressure, diabetes, and more. Health screenings, physicals and vaccines can also be provided. Prescriptions will be given as needed. Middle Georgia Community Action Agency will be on site to assist with prescription resources. Medications will not be on-site, and dental services will not be available.
