7. Tell what you liked or didn't like about the author's style on the BREAD bottom layer.
8. Last put your sandwich together with a staple.

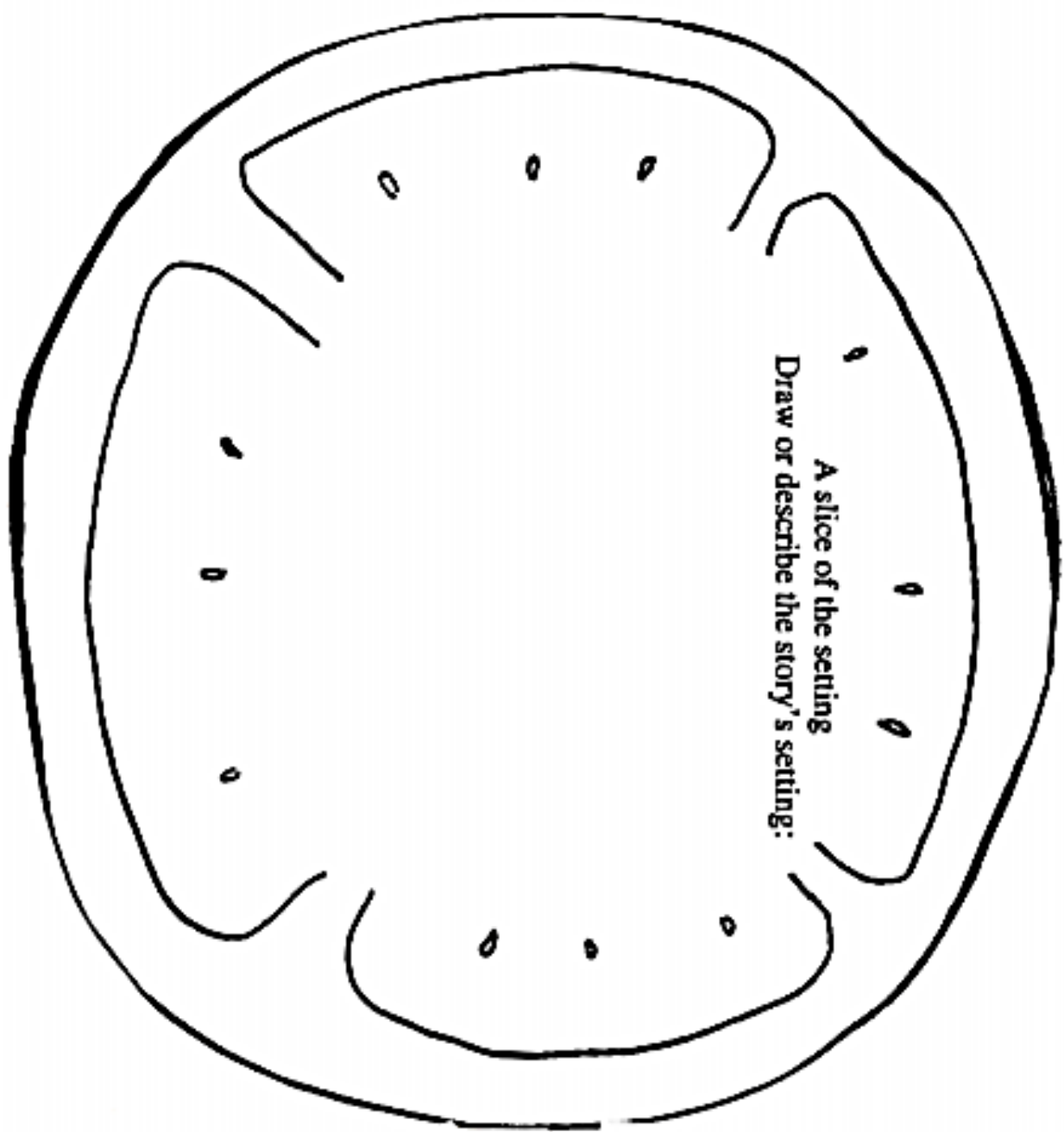

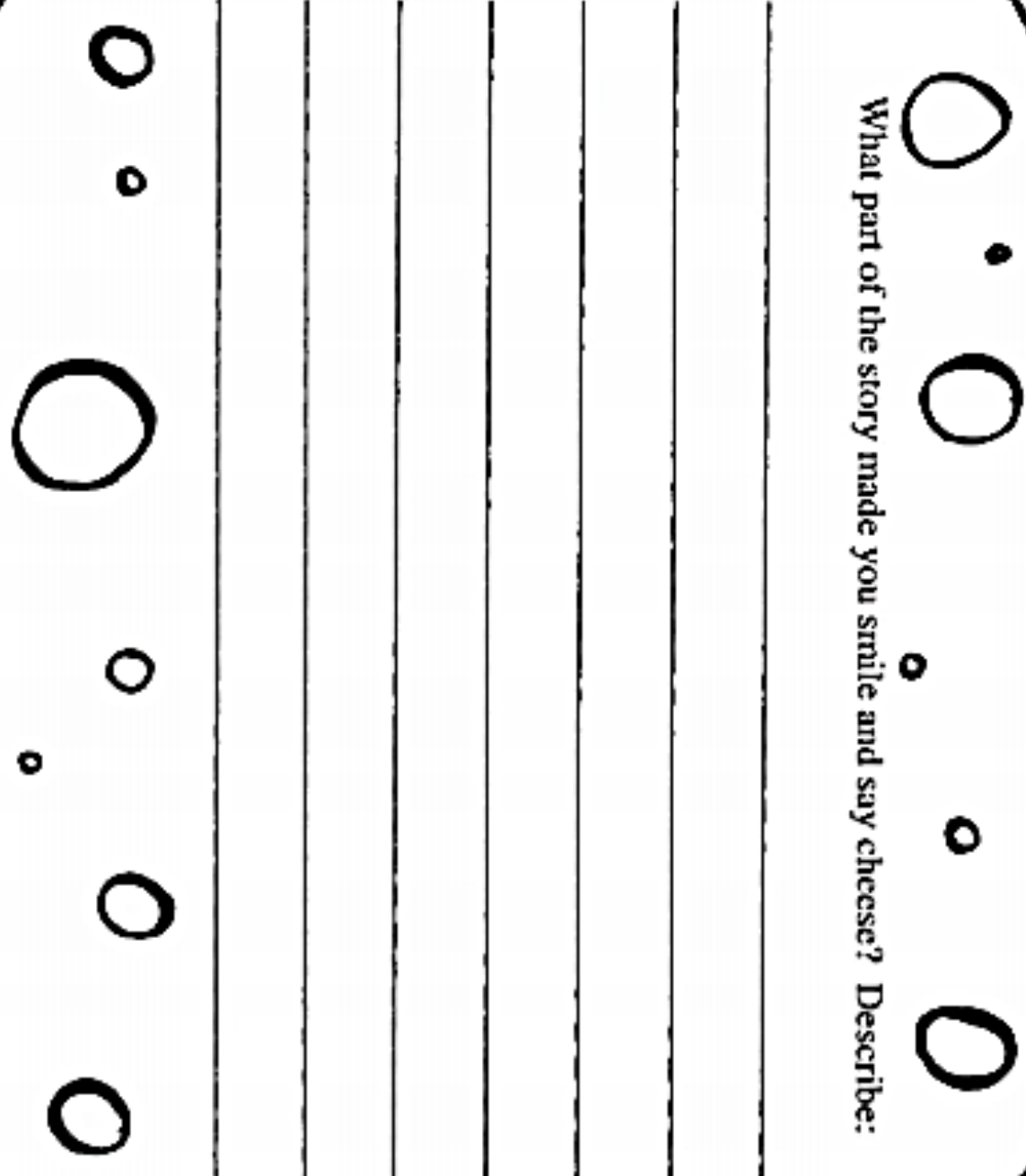

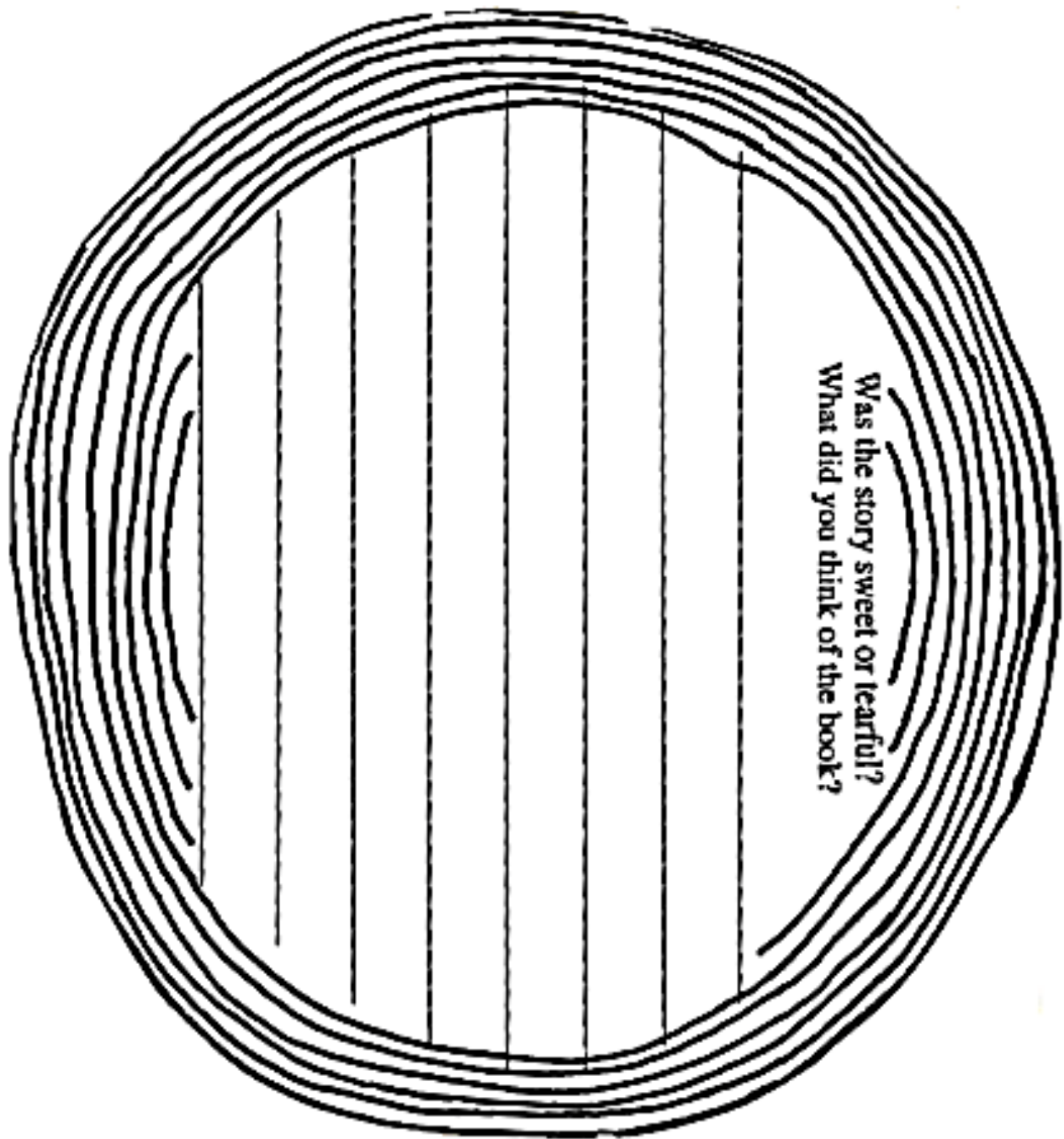
