Some highlights of the Negotiated Agreement are a 3% raise as well as a raise to the fringe benefit for the upcoming year. Fringe benefit will be raised from \$8804 to \$12,275. The second year of the agreement contains a \$2000 increase to the base pay as well as a one-time payment of \$1000.

The superintendent negotiated a \$0 salary raise with a 5-day carryover of vacation days option. Also, the superintendent will follow the teacher negotiated agreement in terms of sick days and rules of carry-over and payout.

I have already paired her up with Miss Binstock to be her mentor.

Kennedy comes to us from Hazen. She is also a first-year teacher who completed her student teaching in Beulah. She went through the DSU teaching program at BSC and recently graduated.

She finished the school year in a long-term subbing position in Hazen. She seemed to have a level of creativity and personality that our students would enjoy.

6. Approve raises for Classified Staff.

What was discussed in the negotiations committee was a 3% raise across the board. They also discussed offering a single health policy to those who take the insurance. A fringe of \$8804 for those who do not take the insurance, which is equivalent to what they have received in the last two years.
