Pre-Algebra:	> 1 calculator	> 1 ruler (inches and centimeters)
Algebra 1:	> 1 pack fine tip dry-erase markers	> 1 one-inch (or larger) 3-ring binder specifically for
Geometry:	> Calculator capable of performing trig functions > A pen that isn't black or blue	> A binder or spiral notebook
Biology:	> 1 one-inch (or larger) 3-ring binder and one small notebook for the biodiversity project > 1 notebook with at least 100 pages specifically for Biology	
Chemistry:	> 1 scientific calculator - make sure the calculator can do scientific notation > 1 composition notebook- minimum 3-subject	
Spanish I, II, III:	> 2 fine tip dry-erase markers	> 1 spiral notebook and a 2-pocket folder
9th and 10th grade Bible:	> 1 folder > Notebook	> 1 Bible of dynamic or literal translation (ESV, NIV, CSB, NLT, NKJV, NASB)
12th grade Bible:	> spiral notebook for taking notes	> blank journal
