

Appropriate Use of Technology Agreement

The District may provide technology devices to students, teachers, and other personnel who attend or are employed by the District. Technology devices can include laptops, chromebooks, iPads, and/or tablets. The use of the devices shall be in support of education, research and the educational goals of the District. To assure that the device is used in an appropriate manner and for the educational purposes intended, the District will require all who use District technology/equipment to follow the guidelines and procedures for appropriate use. Anyone who misuses, abuses, or chooses not to follow the device guidelines and procedures may be subject to disciplinary and/or legal action.

I agree to the following:

- I will not download any software on any technology equipment 's hard drive (including games, music, video or etc.) without permission from the IT Department.
- I understand this equipment is the property of the District and must be returned in the same condition it was issued to me.
- I will be financially responsible for equipment that is lost, stolen or damaged. I understand that there may be charges to my family if the laptop or technology provided is damaged, lost or stolen.
- I will not leave the technology equipment in an unsecured area.
- I will use the equipment for educational purposes only, will be responsible for the proper use of
 this equipment and will not allow any other students or person to use the equipment assigned
 to me.
- I will abide by all of the District's technology policies and guidelines.
- I understand that all information stored on equipment carries no expectation of privacy and is
 the property of the District. The District reserves the right to inspect and search any and all of
 the property for the purpose of determining whether any policy was violated or when an
 inspection and investigation is necessary for promoting safety compliance with state and
 federal laws.
- I will immediately report theft or damage of any kind to District IT staff.



Damaged and Lost Device Fines 2023-2024
