6th Grade Band:

6th Grade Band provides an introduction and development of instrumental music. Student's will be responsible for providing their instruments, excluding tubas and larger percussion instruments, and their instrument specific text book, Essential Elements. Students will learn how to read the music staff and read basic notes and rhythms on the music staff. Students will have performance opportunities throughout the year and will be graded for those performances. Our goal this year is to be reading and performing grade 1 music literature.

7th & 8th Grade Band:

In addition to all of the elements of 6th grade band, 7th & 8th grade students will have additional performance opportunities. These opportunities include the following: The Alabama Music Performance Assessment, University Honor Bands, Solo & Ensemble, District Honor Band, & Alabama All-State Honor Band. Our goal for the 7th & 8th grade students is to be able to read and perform Grade 2 Music Literature.

Grading Policy:

Weekly Rehearsal Grade/Daily Work 40% Major Assessments/ Performances 60%

Rehearsal Grades:

- There is no "sitting on the bench" in band! Every person is important! That's why you will receive 100 points per week. If you do not participate in class, disrupt the rehearsal, chew gum, or forget to bring your positive attitude to rehearsals, points will be deducted from your daily rehearsal grade.

Daily Work and Major Assessments:

- In order to effectively perform music literature, every student is expected to learn the material presented in class. In order to assess this, daily work may be given. This includes worksheets, recordings, music notation quizzes, and playing tests.
- Major assessments will be similar to daily grades but will be weighted as a major grade.
 recordings and playing tests will only be given close to concert dates to assure the music was practiced and mastered.

Performances:

We will have up to three concerts a year. These concerts are why we are here so it's
essential that everyone makes it to the concert. If you know there will be a conflict with a

- concert date, please contact me and let me know ASAP. Alternate assignments will only be given if there is an excused absence for that school day.
- The Millbrook Middle School 7th & 8th grade band will also perform at all home football games. These will be considered test grades.

Course Fee & Fundraising:

There is a \$80 course fee per student. This fee helps to provide students with additional materials, such as music, emergency reeds, and other maintenance items. This fee will also cover us purchasing a specific band T-shirt to wear for school events, and other off campus events. We will have fundraising to help cover this fee. If you fundraise past the fee, the balance can be used for trips, and roll over to the next school year. (excluding 8th graders)

Uniforms:

In order for students to be uniform, we will have band T-shirts made to sell at cost. This is included into the fee for students. Also for 7th and 8th grade band, concert attire may need to be purchased. We will wear "Concert Black" for concert performances, unless otherwise announced.. This needs to be a long sleeve black collared shirt, long black slacks/skirt, long black socks, and black dress shoes (flats for ladies). All concert attire must meet school dress code. Jeans and tennis shoes will not suffice for concert attire. If you have any questions about this, please let me know.

Other Opportunities:

If your student decides to audition for All State Band or University Honor Bands there will be separate costs for auditions and the event. These will be announced as the Alabama BandMasters Association & Universities announces details of these events throughout the year. We will also do fundraising throughout the year. This will help to buy new sound equipment, instruments, and other opportunities for the future development of our program.
