Principal Report (Ms. Thompson)

- We hosted a successful spelling bee, thanks in part to our 8th grade Ambassadors.
- The budget was approved; a letter will be sent out next week.
- Enrollment Dashboard
 - Enrollment is currently at 289.
 - We're attracting great people. Marc Holmes is helping us start early. We made 10 offers after the recent testing day!

Financial Report (Phil)

- For re-enrollment, we're already at 46, which is unheard of for January!
- We reviewed the finances as of the end of November.
- Revenue was favorable to budget.
- Expenses were favorable to budget. The only item unfavorable was utilities (water), but it's expected to average out to match the budget by end of year.

Catholic Identity (Yung)

- We're planning a service project over spring break.
- We're coordinating deacon visits.
- We're trying to bring Catechesis of the Good Shepherd to the third grade classrooms.

Community Vitality (Beth)

- We're expecting 300 people for the Smart Families "Family Code" dinner, which will include a lecture on family values and a giveaway of *The Amazing Generation*.

Development Committee Update (Daniel)

- Last night, the Development Committee talked about the parish's 50th anniversary celebration in June.
 - They want to get a list of the heavy donors to the school to recognize them at a dinner.
 - Do we want to coincide the celebration of the 25th year of the school with the church's 50th? No, because we're in our 24th year. (But SJCS has plans to celebrate our 25th next year with a special silver auction.)
 - Would students (cheer, band) perform during the anniversary celebration?

Volunteerism (Angela)

- We're adding more volunteers for library, lunch duty, art, copying, spelling bee, flower committee, auction, and the Gallup poll.
- We're getting "job descriptions."
