To Parents of Students Enrolled in First Grade Classes for September, 2022:

It is my pleasure to announce Oxford's self-supporting Summer Learning program for 2022. Classes will be held four days a week - Monday through Thursday, beginning July 5th and continuing until August 4th, 2022.

"Whales of Fun" will be offered during the five weeks listed above, from 8:30 - 11:30 a.m. at Quaker Farms School. **Parents** are responsible for transportation to and from QFS.

The fee for this class is \$280. ONCE REGISTRATION IS CONFIRMED, YOU WILL RECEIVE AN E-MAIL WITH A LINK TO MAKE YOUR PAYMENT ELECTRONICALLY. PAYMENT IS DUE WITHIN 7 DAYS OF E-MAIL RECEIPT.

Course Description: This class is for children who have completed their Kindergarten year and are entering first grade. "Whale" your way through the summer days on land by participating in a whale unit. Students will do various language arts activities such as poetry, singing, journals, and whale-related stories. We will also make fish puppets and a large whale in an ocean mural. Math activities such as graphing, estimating, and measuring will be applied in this class. It will be a whale of a summer at Quaker Farms School! Come and join us for learning and lots of fun!

Sufficient enrollment is essential; if the minimum (6 students per class) is not reached, a refund will be issued and the class will be cancelled. Parents will be informed if this measure must be taken.
