Charge Policy

What about breakfast?

Breakfast is offered daily at each school. Meal times vary by school site.

Breakfast meals consist of four items.

1. One ½ pint of milk.
2. One serving of fruit, vegetable, or fruit combined with juice, AND
3. Two servings of bread and/or cereal, OR
4. Or a bread serving with a lesser serving of meat or meat alternate, OR
5. One serving of bread/cereal and one serving of meat/meat alternate.

****For breakfast each student must choose at least 3 components.**

Meat/meat alternate servings are not a required breakfast component, however, are incorporated to the meal pattern for breakfast.

****One of the items may be declined. However, the price is still the same. Students MUST choose a fruit selection as one of their items as required by federal law.**

Non-Discrimination Statement
