Every year, the LAS Links Test is administered in January to English as a Second Language (ESL) Students. This language assessment scale test assesses students in the domains of reading, writing, speaking, and listening. In order for students to meet language proficiency and exit from the English as a Second Language program, they must achieve a score of "4" in reading, writing, and overall.

This year, 27 students were tested across the district in Grades K-12. Five students achieved English language proficiency and exited out of the ESL program.
