Vocabulary Words-beak, believe, energy, notes, pecks, resting, sensitive, tie

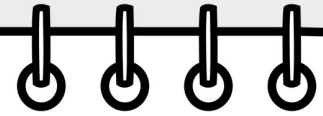
Writing-Opinion
