## The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery

(ASVAB) will be administered on Friday, November 4th at 7:30 am in the High School Gymnasium. This test will be administered to the entire 10<sup>th</sup> grade class and is also available FREE to interested 11th and 12th grade stu-

dents. The ASVAB is an excellent career exploration tool. The test helps identify the student's interests and aptitude in the following areas: verbal, math, science and technical skills. When the students' scores are interpreted, he/she will learn how their interests and skills relate to the demands of more than 400 occupations, helping them to identify suitable career options. It is also used by all branches of the military for persons interested in joining the military. Taking the test does NOT in any way obligate a student to the military. 10<sup>th</sup> grade students cannot use their scores for enlistment eligibility.

All 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will be automatically registered to take the exam, but students in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade interested in taking the exam need to sign up by clicking on the following link: <u>ASVAB Registration</u>. Again, there is NO charge for the test.
