PBIS School-Wide Celebrations



For the 23-24 school year, BES will have quarterly school-wide celebrations. We believe that all students show positive behavior throughout the quarter, so regardless of referrals and classroom consequences all students will always be able to attend some portion of the celebration.

How do students lose time at these celebrations?

- Classroom behavior tracking- breakdowns can be found on the following page
- Office Referrals- Parents will be required to sign these as an acknowledgment of the situation and an understanding that this will result in the student missing quarterly celebration time.

Quarter 1

- → 1st office referral will not result in moving up a level
- → Any additional office referrals will result in a student being moved up a level

Quarters 2-4

→ Any office referral will result in a student being moved up a level

Why are the celebration criteria different from quarter to quarter?

- → At the beginning of the year, the celebration criteria are lower to allow students extra chances as they are becoming familiar (or refamiliarizing themselves) with acceptable school behavior.
- → The number of school days in the quarter- fewer days mean fewer days to earn celebration time
- → As students grow, mature, and more clearly understand behavior expectations, the criteria for celebrations become higher

Tell me more about the classroom behavior systems.

- → They may differ slightly by grade level, but there are some uniformities among all the grade levels.
- → Clipboards follow students around to all places during the school day (lunchroom, PE, music, recess, etc.) This allows for homeroom teachers to easily keep track of any behavior issues throughout the building.
- → When a student's behavior reaches an unacceptable threshold for a day, parents will be made aware of it (K & 1 through behavior folders and 2-5 via strike sheets)
- → Teachers will make parents aware when their child has reached a level that will result in the student missing time from the celebration.

Here is what we have planned so far for school-wide celebrations:

- → Quarter 1- October~ Bounce Houses (about 45 minutes)
- → Quarter 2- December 21st- Wheel of Wisdom- 1 show (approx. 1 hour)
- → Quarter 3- March 17th- unknown- Student Council will help decide
- → Quarter 4- Last day of school- unknown- Student Council will help decide

1st Quarter Classroom Behavior Level Breakdown

For the <u>1st quarter</u>, we will have a graduated behavior system for student attendance at the celebration. We will start keeping track of levels on August 28th for Q1. This allows teachers time to teach students expected behaviors. Levels will reset the day after the 1st Q celebration.

<u>Level 1-</u> Miss 5 min. <u>Level 2-</u> Miss 15 min. <u>Level 3-</u> Miss 25min. <u>Level 4-</u> Miss 35 min.

For Kindergarten, levels will be determined by behavior calendars

Level 1- 2 office referrals Miss 5 min.

Level 2-3 office referrals-Miss 15 min.

Level 3- 4 office referrals- Miss 25 min.

Level 4-5 office referrals- Miss 35 min.

For 1st grade, levels will be determined by daily calendars/clipboards

Level 1-15 clipboard marks-Miss 5 min.

Level 2- 20 clipboard marks and/or 2 notes on the behavior calendar- Miss 15 min.

Level 3- 25 clipboard marks and/or 4 notes on the behavior calendar- Miss 25 min.

Level 4- 30 clipboard marks and/or 5 notes on the behavior calendar- Miss 35 min.

For 2nd Grade- levels will be determined by strike sheets

Level 1- 4 strikes sheets-Miss 5 min.

Level 2- 8 strike sheets-Miss 15 min.

Level 3- 12 strike sheets- Miss 25 min.

Level 4- 16 strike sheets-Miss 35 min.

For 3rd Grade-levels will be determined by strike sheets

Level 1- 4 strikes sheets- Miss 5 min.

Level 2- 8 strike sheets- Miss 15 min.

Level 3- 12 strike sheets- Miss 25 min.

Level 4- 16 strike sheets-Miss 35 min.

For 4th Grade-levels will be determined by Friday behavior incentives

Level 1- 2 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive- Miss 5 min.

Level 2- 4 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive- Miss 15 min.

Level 3- 6 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive- Miss 25 min.

Level 4-8 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive-Miss 35 min.

For 5th Grade- levels will be determined by strike sheets

Level 1- 15 strikes on the clipboard- Miss 5 min.

Level 2- 30 strikes on the clipboard- Miss 15 min..

Level 3-45 strikes on the clipboard-Miss 25 min.

Level 4- 60 strikes on the clipboard- Miss 35 min.

Q1- Students will also move up a level for any office referral after the first.

3rd & 4th Quarter Classroom Behavior Levels Breakdown

For the <u>3rd & 4th quarters</u>, we will have a graduated behavior system for student attendance at the celebration. We will start keeping track of levels on January 10th for Q3. Levels will reset on March 20th for the 4th quarter. There are 46 days of Q3 and 45 days of Q4 to earn this celebration.

For Kindergarten, levels will be determined by behavior calendars

- Level 1-7 notes written on monthly behavior calendar-Miss 10 min.
- Level 2- 12 notes written on monthly behavior calendar- Miss 20 min.
- Level 3-17 notes written on monthly behavior calendar-Miss 30 min.
- Level 4- 22+ notes written on the monthly behavior calendar- Miss 40 min.

For 1st grade, levels will be determined by daily calendars/clipboards

- Level 1- 10 clipboard marks-Miss 10 min.
- Level 2-15 clipboard marks and/or 2 notes on the behavior calendar- Miss 20 min.
- Level 3- 20 clipboard marks and/or 4 notes on the behavior calendar- Miss 30 min.
- Level 4- 25 clipboard marks and/or 5 notes on the behavior calendar- Miss 40 min.

For 2nd Grade-levels will be determined by strike sheets

- Level 1- 3 strikes sheets-Miss 10 min.
- Level 2- 6 strike sheets- Miss 20 min.
- Level 3- 9 strike sheets- Miss 30 min.
- Level 4- 12 strike sheets-Miss 40 min.

For 3rd Grade-levels will be determined by strike sheets

- Level 1- 3 strikes sheets- Miss 10 min.
- Level 2- 6 strike sheets- Miss 20 min.
- Level 3- 9 strike sheets- Miss 30 min.
- Level 4- 12 strike sheets- Miss 40 min.

For 4th Grade- levels will be determined by Friday behavior incentives

- Level 1- 2 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive- Miss 10 min.
- Level 2-3 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive- Miss 20 min.
- Level 3-4 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive-Miss 30 min.
- Level 4-5 missed weeks of Friday Behavior Incentive-Miss 40 min.

For 5th Grade-levels will be determined by strike sheets

- Level 1- 10 strikes on the clipboard- Miss 10 min.
- Level 2- 20 strikes on the clipboard- Miss 20 min.
- Level 3- 30 strikes on the clipboard- Miss 30 min.
- Level 4- 40 strikes on the clipboard- Miss 40 min.

As a reminder students will also move up a level for any office referral after the first.
