

Scholarship Opportunity for Future Teacher Provided by CCERA

The Covington County Education Retirees Association (CCERA) has committed the organization to provide a scholarship annually for a Covington County student pursuing a career in the education field. The association is composed of retired teachers, administrators, school board members, support personnel and associate members. Seven meetings are scheduled each year for CCERA business and programs. CCERA members are active in community volunteerism such as tutoring schools, community literacy projects, church activities, as well as community development projects. Community service hours are tallied at each meeting and submitted annually to the Alabama Education Retirees Association.
