#### Naming of New High School in Northeast Randolph

Superintendent Donald E. Andrews reported to the Board that a committee had met and reviewed names recommended for the new high school in the northeast part of the county. He stated that even though several names of worthy individuals were submitted for consideration, the committee decided not to recommend the school be named after an individual or a directional indication. He stated that the committee recommended three names for the new school: Providence Grove High School, Providence Ridge High School, and Providence Creek High School, and that the committee gave priority to the name Providence Grove High School. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by J. Johnson that the Board approve the name Providence Grove High School for the new high school in northeast Randolph County. The motion carried: 7-0.
