## Job Description

### Purpose:

The SMJUHSD is in its third year of Program Improvement (PI). The basis for PI is the federal accountability measures that hold schools responsible for the achievement of ALL students. Therefore, those students who have attendance problems or are frequently out of school for any reason create a challenge for educators as they too need to demonstrate proficiency in all core areas. On Campus Suspension offers an academic advantage by permitting students to make up school work that is otherwise missed when a student is sent home or is placed in a traditional detention hall.

### Program Goal:

Discipline is a part of the educational process therefore; the goal of the On Campus Suspension (OCS) teacher is to meet the academic requirements of students who have been placed in an alternative learning environment due to problems with tardies or other student misconduct while they develop proper behaviors using other resources on campus.
