## FINAL EXAMINATIONS

Final examinations in Carnegie credit courses may be used to evaluate student achievement when conducted in such a way that they effectively estimate the achievement of the goals and objectives on which learning activities have been based. The Jefferson Davis Parish School Board shall require, however, all students in Carnegie credit courses to take final examinations for each subject in which the student is enrolled. All final examinations shall be administered according to a schedule recommended by the principal and approved by the Superintendent.

Carnegie credit courses that are taught in the fall or spring semesters that are one semester, ½ credit, and/or one semester, accelerated one full credit, shall be required to take a final examination. Credit for courses taken and quality points earned shall be in accordance with the School Board's *Pupil Progression Plan*.

No teacher shall schedule a final examination other than in accordance with the School Board's approved schedule for such examinations.
