Read with Me – Literacy Initiative: October 16th, 23rd, 30th, 2025, from 5:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. The LSSC is partnering with the Houston County Family Connection to provide a 6-week literacy course for families who want to learn how to teach their children to read. This class is for families who have a child between the ages of 0-8 years old and fall under a qualifying demographic. Register for more information: Read with Me Literacy Registration

Clinic Day: October 28th from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

The LSSC and the Georgia Department of Public Health - North Central Health District are partnering to bring health appointments to the families in Houston County. Appointments are available on a first come, first served basis and pre-registration is required. The appointments will be free or low cost for families. Nurses are able to treat mild/moderate conditions, high blood pressure, diabetes, and more. Health screenings, physicals and vaccines can also be provided. Prescriptions will be given as needed. Middle Georgia Community Action Agency will be on site to assist with prescription resources. Medications will not be on-site and dental services will not be available. Mobile Mammogram Clinic: October 29th from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

The LSSC will host a one-day, on-site Mobile Mammogram Clinic in partnership with Atrium Health Navicent to increase access to preventive breast cancer screenings for our school community and surrounding families. The Mobile Clinic is for Houston County School District employees, parents/guardians, and community members (appointments recommended, walk-ins welcome except during the hours of 12 p.m. - 1 p.m.).

Candidates must meet the following criteria to have a mammogram:

- 35 years old or older (anyone under the age of 40 years old will be responsible for making sure their health insurance covers screening mammogram)
- Not currently receiving treatment for or diagnosed with breast cancer within the past 2 years
- No new breast health issues such as a palpable lump, skin changes or nipple discharge
- Not currently breastfeeding and have not breastfed within the last 6 months
- No mammogram within the last 12 months.
