Science	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two (2) semesters of Physical Science in Grade-9 • Two (2) semesters of Biology in Grade-10 • Two (2) semesters during Junior or Senior Year
Social Studies	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two (2) semesters of World History in Grade 9 • Two (2) semesters of United States History in Grade-10 • Two (2) semesters of Government in Grade-12
Health	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One (1) semester of Health in Grade-10
Physical Education	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taken anytime while in grades 9-12
Consumer Economics & Personal Finance	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two (2) semesters in Grade 12.
