The Pre-Kindergarten teacher will ensure all students are Kindergarten ready by acquiring the prerequisite skills to make a successful transition to Kindergarten. Will establish positive relationships with students, parents, administration, school staff, and outside agencies. Will work directly with the FACE Program Data Collector to share and provide information relating to the progress in the program.

Qualifications: Education level required: Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood education or related field. Must possess a valid South Dakota Teaching License. Experience in pre-kindergarten or kindergarten preferred.
