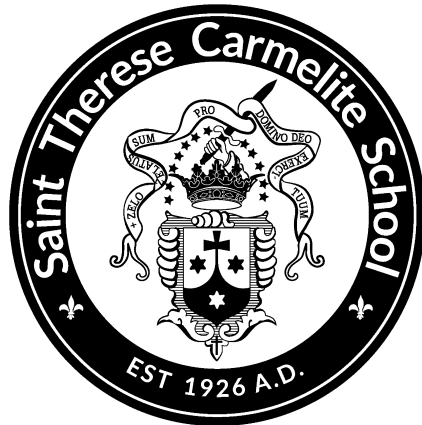

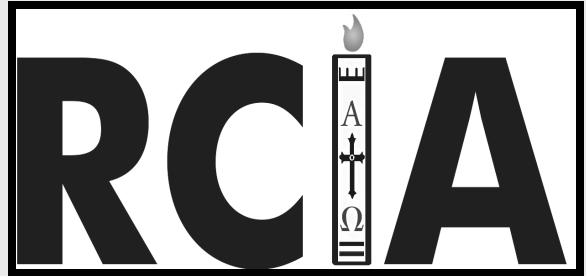

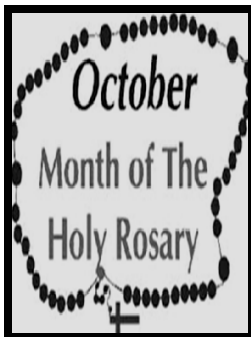
R.C.I.A.-FAITH FORMATION

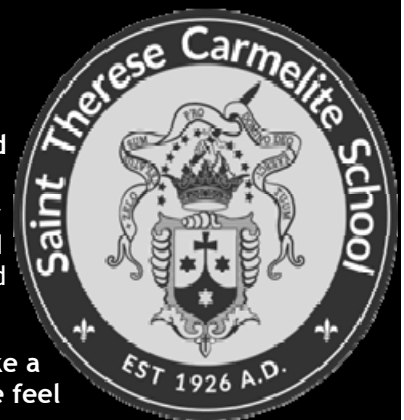
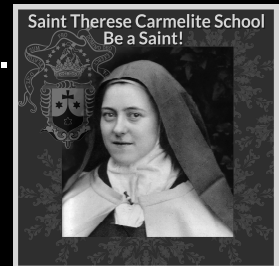

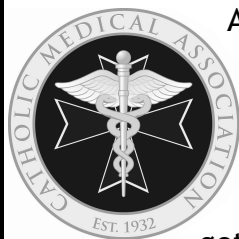


Baptism Ministry

PARENTS & GODPARENTS are required to attend a class from 7:30 to 9:00 p.m., in the Parish Library (next will be November 2 and December 7). The fee is \$100 per child OR \$25 for the class only. Baptisms are on Saturdays (next open are November 18 and December 23, 11:00 a.m.).

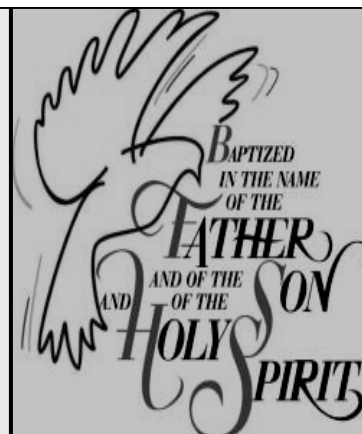
CATHOLIC MEDICAL ASSOCIATION
