Greenville Area School District Student Acceptance Form

Greenville Area School District students will be issued a Chromebook for their educational use. This Student Chromebook Acceptance Form (the "Agreement") ensures that equipment supplied by the Greenville Area School District (the "District") will be used and maintained in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, by the student who signs it ("Student"). By signing this form, the student will demonstrate reasonable care with respect to the security and physical well-being of the equipment assigned to his/her care. In the absence of reasonable care or if the equipment is returned in a condition different than the original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, the student will be financially responsible. In addition, in the event the Greenville Area School District determines in its sole discretion that the borrower did not utilize reasonable care in the use of the equipment, the student will be responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen equipment. The Chromebook and its accessories are the property of the District.

Please do not remove any Identification Tags from any component. If in the event that any of these tags become removed, please notify the school office IMMEDIATELY for a replacement.

By signing this agreement, the student acknowledges and agrees:

- To abide by the District Acceptable Use Policy 815.
- To use the Chromebook primarily for educational use.
- That the Chromebook is issued to the student who, with his/her parents or guardians, are the only authorized users of the Chromebook.
- That while the equipment is connected to the Internet, its use will be logged.
- To not attempt to circumvent the District's Internet content filter.
- The District will provide remote Internet content filtering, however the filter should not be used as a substitute for parental supervision.
- To not install or remove any software without prior authorization from the District.
- To report any problems or damages immediately to their teacher.
- That the device and its accessory equipment (case, battery, and power cord & block) are the property of the District.
- To return the equipment before the student's last day of school if the student is transferring out of the District.
- That if the equipment is not returned to the District within fourteen (14) days of the student's withdrawal from the District in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, or if the equipment is damaged, lost, or stolen, due to student's negligence or not utilizing reasonable care in the use of the equipment, the student agrees to be financially responsible for the replacement value of the equipment as determined by the District.

- Upon failure to comply with the Acceptance Form regarding return of the equipment, the District will take all appropriate action. If the materials and equipment are not returned within five (5) days after written request, the District will notify the local police department and file charges of theft by unlawful disposition. A court hearing will be set. Regardless of whether the materials are returned, the Student/Parent will be required to respond to the criminal charges and may be fined and may be responsible for restitution of the District for the value of the returned item(s).
- That all information stored on equipment carries no expectation of privacy and is property of the District.
- That it is the student's responsibility to accept all chrome updates.

By signing this form, the Student acknowledges and agree that any information or use of the equipment carries no expectation of privacy. The District reserves the right, at all times and without prior notice, to inspect and search any and all its property for the purpose of determining whether any policy has been violated, or when an inspection and investigation is necessary for purposes of promoting safety or compliance with state and federal laws.
