4. The ages of the children must be given as they are on May 31, 1919. If a child removes from the district during the fifteen days preceding June 1, he should be enrolled in the district in which he is resident May 31, 1919.
5. Place opposite the names of pupils enrolled in the 7th or 8th grade, in the column provided, the number of the grade in which they have been enrolled during the year ending July 14, 1919. The total must agree with items 2a and 2b front of blank.
