Online/Dual Credit Students

The following guidelines apply to students who would like to enroll in online or dual-credit courses. Each student and situation will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis with supporting documentation.

- A student who enrolled in online or dual-credit courses must be present in the building at their assigned location. Students are no longer allowed to stay at home or leave the building for those courses.
- If an in-person class is offered at the high school, students will not be allowed to enroll in an online or dual-credit course for that class.
- If a student fails an online or dual-credit course, they will no longer be allowed to enroll in one.
- Must maintain a 90% or higher yearly attendance rate.
- To appeal a decision, students/parents should contact the school counselor in writing to begin the appeals process.
