

## Portrait of a Panther Presentation Criteria

- Create a digital presentation based on the criteria below (PowerPoint, Slides, Canva, etc.) If you have a different idea of how to present your information, please share that with your principal.
- Present yourself professionally:
  - Dress appropriately - wear something you would wear to a job interview (or match the job that you hope to attain)
  - Introduce yourself and shake hands with each panel member
  - Maintain eye contact throughout the presentation
  - Be aware of your body language
  - Use appropriate language and voice control
  - Be punctual - show up on time and be ready to present
- Be prepared to present your information to your panel (standing presentation) and expect follow-up questions from your panel members in an interview type setting.

### Presentation Requirements

#### Slide 1: QUOTE THAT REPRESENTS YOU

- Find a documented quote that reflects your personality and/or values.
- Explain to your panel why your quote means something to you.

#### Slide 2: CHALLENGES

- Define at least one challenge that you have faced throughout your high school years (inside or outside of school) that has forced you to grow as a person and/or as a student.
- What did you learn about yourself by going through this challenge?

#### Slide 3-6: MASTERY OF PORTRAIT OF A PANTHER SKILLS

- Choose at least 4 of the Portrait of a Panther Skills (1 per competency) and defend your mastery of the skill with one piece of evidence from a class/program activity, assignment, or project.

#### Slide 7: RESUME

- Provide a link to your professional resume on this slide of your presentation
- Also, bring hard copies (5) of your resume to distribute to each panel member
  - If you need assistance printing your resume, see a faculty member in advance of your scheduled presentation.

#### Slide 8: NEXT STEPS PLAN

- What are you planning to do after high school graduation?
- Provide evidence of your plan. For example, a college acceptance letter, completed job application, communication with military recruiter, etc.

#### Slide 9: CLOSING STATEMENT

- Answer the question, "How has the Portrait of a Panther process been helpful **to you?**"
