FINANCIAL RECAP

Your Generosity, God's Supply!

The annual meeting of the MLC board and constituents was held on September 21. Treasurer Thomas Stoneking's report of God's supply for another year was received with thanksgiving. The founding vision of MLC was to keep tuition costs manageable through annual operational support from churches and donor households. Since 1901, the school has prospered by way of an annual financial miracle as hundreds of individual donors join supporting agencies to provide well over half of the school's operating costs.

Annual donations (rounded) for operational support for fiscal '21 looked like this:

- Direct donations/bequests/memorials \$303,000
- Commodity donations and sales \$112,000
- Grants received \$140,000
- Church donations \$22,000
- *Christian Leadership Foundation \$69,000
- Fund-raising projects \$57,000 [Fruit sales, Hy-Vee and Maynard's Scrip, Auction, Pow Wow food sales, and more]

TOTAL - \$703,000

* The Christian Leadership Foundation (CLF) is an independent corporation established to support MLC and other Christian schools in SW MInnesota. Holdings exceeded \$1 million for the first time in the past fiscal year. Donors seeking to provide endowed, long-term support for MLC may want to consider giving to CLF.

Your generosity as detailed above permitted MLC to begin the new fiscal year with \$50,000 on hand. Because MLC operates without debt, this small cash reserve is very important. MLC PARENTS: Annual vision screening helps to detect potential eye problems, but is not a substitute for a comprehensive, professional eye exam by an eye doctor.

Students who do not pass this initial screening are re-screened about two or three weeks later. If a concern is noted at that time, a letter will be sent to you, requesting that you make an appointment for your child to see a doctor.

If your child wears glasses or contact lenses, please make sure he/she has them along on the day of screening. All students in the school will be screened this year.
