Coordinate with classroom teachers, other educators and parents by providing suggested activities to enhance the student's educational progress and performance.</li> <li>4. Consult with parents regarding student needs/progress.</li> <li>6. Construct, modify and maintain adaptive equipment for positioning, activities of daily living, vocational and classroom use.</li> <li>7. Facilitate in-service education for districts; train and monitor teachers and paraprofessionals to assist in the maintenance of motor objectives.</li> <li>8.
