

Mighty Indian Band Students and Parents:

The Mighty Indian Band members of all levels have been working hard this year and our Christmas Concert is quickly approaching. The concert will be on December 14, 2021 at the FISD Auditorium. *The concert will be split into three time slots for each group; 6<sup>th</sup> grade will perform at 5:00 pm, 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade will perform at 6:00 pm, and High School will perform at 7:00 pm.* Each section of the concert will not take an hour, we are allowing an ample amount of time in between each section of the concert for air in the auditorium to circulate from the previous group. I estimate that 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade band's sections will last 15-20 minutes. After the performance and awards are presented, we are asking that the students and the audience please clear the building as soon as instruments are put away and any pictures are taken. Students are asked to please be in their seats ready to go 20 minutes before their performance time, and audience members will be allowed to take their seats 15 minutes before the performance time.

Those that are not able to attend will be able to watch the concert through a live stream on the FISD Facebook page.

Students are asked to please wear "church attire" for the concert. Nice jeans will be allowed, but absolutely no t-shirts, hoodies, hats, shorts, athletic pants, or tennis shoes will be allowed. Santa hats and Christmas sweaters will be allowed as long as they do not distract from the concert.

This concert is a chance for your student to show off the hard work they have done so far this year; please do absolutely everything in your power to ensure they are able to show off the hard work they have put into this year of band. Attendance at the concert is mandatory unless I am contacted beforehand.
