The time of year has come again for the Christian County 4-H Communication Contest. We are excited to offer this excellent opportunity for our students. A speech contest is fun, engaging, and challenging. It will assist our students to develop their communication skills, grow as an individual, be better speakers, and improve self-confidence.

Students throughout the school will compete, in age divisions, with two winners from each age category advancing to the county contest. County Contest will be March 30, 2021.

Crofton Dates will be the last week of February and the first week of March – exact times and dates for age categories will be sent home later

- Student must be 9 or older as of January 1, 2021
- May do a Speech or Demonstration
- Speeches 3 5 minutes
- Speech topics are unlimited
- Demonstrations 5 -15 minutes
- Demonstration topics list available
- Speech must be an original
- Judges decisions will be final

Parents and student need to discuss if they are interested in participating. If so, fill out the section below, and return to your homeroom teacher. Your child will need support at home for selecting a topic, organizing ideas, writing the final speech, making note cards, and practicing their speech/demonstration.

Many examples of speeches and demonstrations can be found on You Tube that may help with decisions. But remember yours must be your own work, an original from you.

Participants are to record their speech or demonstration and submit to the school for judging. Videos must be submitted by March 12th.
