Purpose:

- Support Owosso Public Schools staff members in an innovative environment where students come first by providing grants (2021-22 for second semester)

Criteria:

- One application per staff member
- Grants will be available Preschool to 12th Grade
- Looking for programs, events, or materials that support the Foundation's focus on:
 - Health and Wellness
 - Educational Enrichment
 - Career & Technical Education
 - Technology
 - Arts
- Grants may be written for up to \$500 & up to \$1,000.

Expectations:

Spreading the Word: For each grant awarded a flyer would go home with students who benefited, explaining that OPS Foundation supported the activity. If materials are supported with this money, there will be OPS Foundation labels of acknowledgement for funding merchandise.

Timeline:

January 14, 2022: Grants awards will be announced.
