

It Matters: Building Character

Focus on four areas as you help your child develop character



Your child may have been born with certain personality traits, but think of their character as a work in progress. In other words, the kind of person they will eventually become is still being shaped. Teach them to:

1. **Be flexible.** Model compromise and negotiation by listening to the opinions of others.

Encourage your child to do the same.

2. **Show empathy.** Teach your child to imagine how others might feel and to treat them with kindness. Make caring for others a priority in your family.

3. **Have self-control.** Tell your child that they can't control others, but they can control their own choices, actions and reactions. Encourage them to always think before they act.

4. **Take responsibility.** Let your child know that responsibilities are like promises. They are things he or she has to do especially when others are counting on you.

SEL Tip for the Month

(Social Emotional Learning)

Create moments with your children to try something new. As your children grow older, they will meet people from different walks of life, visit new places, and new experiences. Trying something new together creates a stronger bond, new memories, and lets your children know that it is ok to try something new. It could be something simple like a new dish for dinner or visiting a different theme park.


