







Spotlight on Second Grade



Happy Friday! Today marks a very important time of the year as it is the end of the second trimester. Next Friday you will be able to view your child's report card with your children and review their academic progress. Below are some tips when doing so.

- Always stay positive and supply praise when you review the report card with your child.
- Ask your child how they think they did this marking period. This will help to open a dialogue with your child so they can voice any concerns they may be having and you can discuss how to improve upon any weaknesses.
- Discuss which accomplishments they are most proud of.
- If a comment is made on the report card or a mark for an area for improvement is indicated, discuss this with your child.
- Discuss your child's goals for the next marking period.
- Help your child plan next steps.
